Introduction

Vision and Mission

The Gospel can be spread across the ends of the earth by supporting Christian foundations, schools, and churches with IT tools and IT training.

Who did the request?

What are we going to do?

We also want to promote the ICCM-Africa conference in Kenya and it will be a training conference for Albert. Albert can use the experience on ICCM-Africa. We will also use this conference to promote the KingdomIT Box and look for volunteers for our KingdomIT Box project. As you will understand the ICCM-Europe conference is an important event for the work of KingdomIT.

Where and when will the project be held?

The conference will take place on the Karimu conference centre in Burbach-Holzhausen, Germany; 2.5 hours of driving from the Dutch border. The project will be held from 5 to 8 February 2020.

Why this project?

It is important for KingdomIT to spread our brand, build a network and to come into contact with other mission organisations. It will empower our future mission and projects worldwide.

Apart from this, we are urgently looking for new volunteers for our KingdomIT Box project. ICCM-Europe provides us with a network to find these volunteers. It is also important that Albert obtains experience with ICCM-Europe for his work for the ICCM-Africa project in Kenya, and it is important to keep promoting ICCM-Africa in the ICCM-EU network.

How do we reach our goal

By just being there, connecting with people, being a servant to other missionaries helping them with IT related issues they may have in spare hours. We hope to promote our KingdomIT Box among mission agencies. We have printed leaflets to promote ICCM-Africa and will prepare two workshops: Ansible and LXD Containers.
